**Dimitri Vegas & Like Mike**

**The Grand, Seaport District**

Head to The Grand this coming Monday for a look into the life of this Belgian DJ and record producer duo Dimitri Vegas & Like Mike. Not only is this duo brothers, but they are also some of the top DJs in the world. Starting when electronic music was first becoming main stream, Dimitri had residencies across Greece and in huge clubs in Ibiza. He returned to Belgium to start working with his brother, Like Mike, who was producing at the time. From there, they took the world by storm and started booking huge festivals such as Tomorrowland and Ultra Music Festival. Through their connections such as Axwell and Martin Garrix, they have solidified their hits and even became the first duo to reach the #1 DJ spot on Billboard's top 100 in 2015. Their chart topping hits "Higher Place" and "The Hum" are some of their most recent work with all star DJ's Ne-Yo and Steve Aoki.

**INSIDER TIP** Dimitri Vegas & Like Mike even hosted Tomorrowland and came up with several of the music festivals anthem's. In 2010 it was "Tomorrow ( Give in to the Night) with Dada Life and Tara Mc-Donald. In 2011 it was "The Way We See the World" with NERVO and Afrojack.



**Gather**

This gorgeous spot in the Seaport District makes it well worth the hike. Located with an open floor-plan like no other, this small plate inspired eatery is refreshing in the up and coming Seaport area.

Their menu is a little bit of everything. They have a full brunch menu with benedicts, omlettes and even a BYO waffle menu that has savory and sweet options. But that is just the beginning. There is a full lunch menu including fish tacos with plantains all the way to a lobster cobb salad that sounds to die for. The dinner menu has hot items such as wild boar bolognese and lemon farro risotto. There is a definite outside the box farm to table vibe.

This is the perfect place to go for a quick bite or to enjoy a sit down meal. The view is spectacular and lots of close hot spots are nearby.

**INSIDER TIP** Don't forget to check out the cocktail menu. The "Salute" is my favorite, a delicious blend of prosecco, pama liqueur, rum, lambrusco and orange.
