Bova's Bakery 134 Salem Street North End, Boston

Open 24hrs a day, this cannoli mecca is the perfect place to escape to if you're not quite ready for your night to end.

Bova's Bakery has been family owned and operated since 1926. They boast some of the North End's most delicious Italian baked goods. They specialize in assorted Italian cookies as well as cannolis, tiramisu (voted #1 Tiramisu by Phatom Gourmet), and even savory foods.

Located in the heart of the North End, down a winding cobble stone street, Bova's will be packed anyday in the morning hours as well as any night after 12PM.

Although Bova's specializes in Italian pastries such as lobster tails, fogliatelle, and pizzelles, they also have traditional Sicilian pizza and calzones. All of their recipes are passed down from generation to generation, so you know it will be good.

INSIDER TIP For all of you who maybe had one too many, I would highly suggest ordering a Rice Ball. Bova's is famous for their giant arancini balls stuffed with cheese, meatballs, steak, you name it.
