Owner Mary Ting Hyatt launched Bagelsaurus in 2013 out of a friend's sandwich shop in Brookline. Once she gained traction with her famous combination of a sea salt bagel with honey-rosemary cream cheese, Hyatt knew she needed to expand.

Her brick & mortar store opened in 2014 completely funded by a Kickstarter campaign from locals. Clearly, there is a reason these bagels are so popular.

They have announced their "GRAB BAG-elsaurus" a quick and easy to go baker's dozen with two large cream cheese tubs and two large coffees for \$40, cash only. M.I.A. aka Mathangi Arulpragasam or "Maya" for short, is a British rapper/ singer- songwriter that has deep roots in Sri Lankan culture.

She began her career in 2000 as a visual artist and filmmaker in London. In 2002 she started recording and in 2004 she started gaining traction with her singles "Sunshowers" and "Galang".

From there she dropped her first album "Arular" and her career skyrocketed from there. M.I.A. has racked up nominations for Grammys, Academy Awards and even a Mercury Prize. Rolling Stone even named her one of the defining artists of the 2000's. She hit global success with her single "Paper Planes" which topped the charts of the Top 20 Worldwide ranking and went three times Platinum in the US.

INSIDER TIP Maya's mother has been a seamstress in London and has had a huge role in curating M.I.A.'s iconic style. She is often noted for effortless ability to be a trendsetting and a global trailblazer. She has a unique and distinct fashion presence. Maya turned down the invitation to be on People Magazine's list of "50 Most Beautiful People in the World".
