Bootleg Special
400 Tremont Street
South End, Boston

Head over to the newest hot spot in the South End. Steps from the hotel lies Bootleg Special tucked away in the corner of Tremont Street.

A self-proclaimed "Boil & Bar", Bootleg Special specializes in Cajun-seasoned crustaceans- more broadly New Orleans seafood boils. It was only a matter of time before another Southern-styled eatery emerged on the Boston scene.

The outside of Bootleg Special is incredibly unassuming, it almost has the appeal of a dive bar. But when you enter, you find yourself in a cozy industrialized nook with chandeliers hanging casually from exposed pipes and huge oriental rugs draped over the wood floors.

The menu here has a little bit of everything.

They do everything from small plates to raw bar and full boils to desserts (beignets, naturally.) On the weekends, they even have a full brunch menu including a "Bootleg Benedict" with lobster, crab and crawfish.

INSIDER TIP Bootleg Special was curiously named after the shape of Louisiana - a jagged boot.
